Dear Parents/Carers of Class 12,

Last Monday at their termly meeting the Governing Body agreed to separate Class 12 into two classes for the new academic year.

Class 12 is our only single class group in the school and throughout this year we have received new pupils and the class total has been around 30. However, we have just been notified of a number of new children for September, taking the class to 34. As we have an admission number of 60 across the school, the local authority can continue to admit more children to this year group during the year and it has been our recent experience that additions are made.

The Governors felt that it was in the best educational interests of the children to split from the beginning of the year and we have been able to find the resources to fund this. Initially, the class sizes will be 17 mixed ability pupils in each class and we have recruited a new teacher for the additional class.

Children will meet their new teachers and spend most of the day in their new rooms as part of our school 'moving up' day on Tuesday 7th July.

I am sure you will appreciate the advantages of small class sizes for your child's final year at primary school and I thank you for your ongoing support. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have further queries.
