


## English

- Using your Shadow Cage text, select at least ten words you are not sure of the meaning and research.
- Using as many of your selected words as you can, create two or more paragraphs, trying to create atmosphere for your own version of the story.
- Check your sentences are correctly punctuated especially commas.
- Now write a paragraph using direct speech. Remember.. *"/capital letter/ punctuation /"/ new line new speaker!*
- AIR: What books that create suspense have you read? What made the plot feel tense?
- Listen to a story being read.
- Use the 5/6 spelling list: Test yourself on 10 new words this week.
- Keep writing in your diary! It will be really interesting to read what happened during this time when you are older.



## Maths

- Try to achieve your best score of times tables on Rockstars, Hit the button or Topmarks. Try the link White Rose maths too. <https://whiterosemaths.com/>
- Test all of your times tables. Try using the inverse (dividing) too. <https://play.numbots.com/#/account/search-school>
- Remember squared numbers -  $2 \times 2$   $3 \times 3$   $4 \times 4 \dots$  ( $2^2$   $3^2$   $4^2$ )  
Write out and answer as many as you can (maybe 20 or more?)
- Next, try cubed:  $2 \times 2 \times 2$   $3 \times 3 \times 3$  ( $2^3$   $3^3$   $4^3$ )
- Write down an explanation for someone who doesn't know what squared or cubed is.
- Now create 4-6 word problems involving squared or cubed numbers - can you make some of them have two or three steps to the problem? Don't forget to answer them.
