






## Year 5 Project Homework

<p>In <b>Science</b> we will be studying changes in humans</p> 	<p><b>For your homework you could...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Research human changes from baby to old age</li> <li>• Create a poster highlighting how you have changed over the course of your life so far</li> <li>• Interview family/friends to document how they have changed</li> </ul>
 <p>In <b>English</b> we will be writing instructions and using discussion to answer a question</p>	<p><b>For your homework you could...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read the strange case of origami Yoda</li> <li>• Create some origami and write instructions for how you completed this</li> </ul>
