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JUNIOR LIFE SKILLS

Year 6 went to the town hall today where they completed workshops with several local agencies and emergency services. They learnt how to make a 999 call; the RNLI gave them general water safety advice; Western Power provided a virtual reality experience demonstrating the need for safety around pylons; Dartmoor rescue talked about staying safe on the moors; West Devon recycling gave messages about the importance of living well and the police talked to the children about how to stay safe on line. These talks link with our Personal Social Health Economic curriculum and will continue to be followed up through our work in school.

As always, the teachers accompanying the children reported

excellent behaviour and conduct throughout the workshops.
