Good Morning Everyone

Continuing restrictions mean that we have put alternative arrangements for our school community events. I share your frustration at this, especially when we see large crowded public events going ahead in other areas. But, although our infection rates in Devon are still amongst the lowest in England, the number of cases have risen and particularly within the 20-39 year olds. We have worked so hard as a school for the past 16 months to follow the rules and keep everyone safe as much as we can that it does not feel ethical to risk this now. We will ensure that all children enjoy their summer events, and will hold our sports afternoons, transition days, visits out and visitors in, garden days, leavers' assemblies and end of year celebrations – following our risk assessment and keeping our children in consistent bubble groups.

COVID SYMPTOMS

YOU MUST NOT COME TO SCHOOL if you or a member of your household has any symptoms of Covid 19. The Government rules for 10 days self isolation and testing continue to apply to everyone so do not become rude or abusive to any member of staff if you are asked to comply. We do not speak to you in that way and it is unacceptable for any family member to behave like this.

NHS guidelines for testing

Get tested for coronavirus (COVID-19)

There are different tests you can get to check if you have coronavirus (COVID-19). The test you need depends on why you're getting tested.

The 2 main tests are:

- PCR tests for people with symptoms, they're sent to a lab to be checked
- rapid lateral flow tests only for people who do not have symptoms, they give a result in 30 minutes
