We will be comparing numbers and using rekenreks to help us.

We will be looking at patterns within numbers to 10 and counting beyond 20. We will be practising our automatic recall of number bonds to 5 and some bonds to 10, including subtraction facts. We will be looking closely at the composition of numbers to 10. We will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD?

Read to your child regularly and talk about what has happened in the story. Widen vocabulary by asking for alternative words.

Talk about number problems using numbers to 10 and beyond and doubling, halving and sharing. Names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes

HOMEWORK:

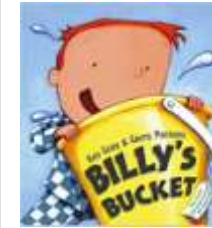
10-15 minutes of daily reading, including tricky words and letter sounds, that were given out in the Autumn Term.
