This week in MATHS:

This week we are focusing on 'Subtraction'. You can use real objects to see that the quantity of a group, can be changed by taking them away. Use the **First, Then, Now** structure to create mathematical stories in meaningful contexts e.g. 'First there were 5 people on the bus. Then 2 people got off the bus. Now there are 3 people on the bus'. Encourage your child to count all the items at the start, take away the required amount practically and recount to see how many are left. Continue to practise counting backwards.

This week in ENGLISH/COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

Read or watch the story 'Super Submarines'
<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=g1RTcJivvpQ>. Discuss as you go through the story and repeat the **vocabulary**. Can you act out the sonar? Draw a picture of a submarine. Write the parts of the submarine on separate pieces of paper. After reading the story, recall the parts of a submarine and stick them onto the picture. Extend by explaining what each part does. Can you write a sentence about the submarine that includes adjectives and conjunctions? Remember to use your beautiful cursive handwriting.

This week in STEM:



Add different resources to plastic eggs (only one resource to each egg) can you predict which resources will sink like a submarine and which will float like a boat?



Art/Design Technology:

Craft submarines. Can you use paper plates, plastic bottles or toilet tubes to make a submarine?
