English

Find a story or a book that you love and reinvent it with an adult. Have a go at changing the characters or the setting and writing your own version. Instead of Podkin One Ear it could be Victoria One Eye.

Create an acrostic poem where the first letters in a line spell out a particular word or phrase when read vertically.

Become a reporter! Investigate events in your house, this could be non-fictional or fictional and create a report. You could be an undercover reporter and interview your family about the missing Rice Crispies. Remember to use time conjunctions (first, next, then, after).

Get creative and practise your year 3/4 spellings. You could use colourful writing, write backwards or upside down or even in graffiti writing! Remember, you can find your spellings in your Home-School diaries or on the internet.



Maths

Speed Challenge! Time yourself counting in 4s and 8s. Can you beat an adult? Can you improve your time?

Write down or get an adult to call out random 3 digit numbers, then add a series of 4s or 8s to that number. E.g. 232, 236, 240.

Tell time using only the hour hand of a clock. Draw or make a junk modeled clock and only use the hour hand. With an adult, see if you can tell the time. Remember the clue is whether the hour hand is $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ past the hour.

Challenge your teacher on Time Table Rock Stars. Set more than one challenge for your teacher to complete. Remember, your login details are in your homework books.

Using your ruler, measure different objects in your house then arrange them in descending and ascending order. Can you convert from cm to mm? Draw any straight sided shapes or interesting image, such as a house, then measure and label each side in cm and mm.



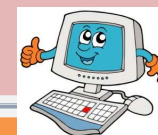
Science and Foundation subjects

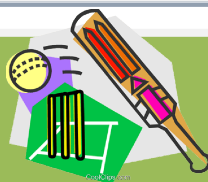
Research the Ancient Greeks and how they lived. Write down a list of things that the Ancient Greeks did in their everyday lives.
