Dear Parents/Carers

We are changing the reading culture at Tavistock Primary. Here is some information to help you understand the changes we are making:

 \cdot Children in Reception and Key Stage I (years I & 2), will read books that contain only words that can be read using the letter sounds (phonics) they have learnt so far.

 \cdot By the end of year one, children will have been taught all the sounds in the English language, all the alternative ways these sounds are spelt (e.g. 'ai' in rain, 'ay' in play 'a-e' in cake) and all the alternative pronunciations for the same sounds (e.g. 'ow' in snow and 'ow' in cow).

· It takes time for this knowledge to be secure and children embed this knowledge at different rates. Once children are secure in recognising and using phonic knowledge in their reading, they will be able to choose any book from the selection of books in the classroom or library.

 \cdot Children's book choice will be carefully monitored by their class teacher to ensure they are able to read their chosen books successfully.

· There will no longer be an expectation for children to read a certain 'colour band'. Books with colour band stickers will still be in our book stock, but these stickers will not be relevant to children's book choices.

If this raises further question, or you would like to have any more information, please talk to your child's class teacher or one of the senior leaders.

Reading Volunteers


We are welcoming volunteers back into school now that some Covid restrictions have been eased. Volunteers make a real difference to children in our school.

Covid 19

Covid Symptoms

YOU MUST NOT COME TO SCHOOL if you have any symptoms of Covid 19. The legal rules for 10 day self isolation and testing continue to apply. - 2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.

- Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.
