This week in MATHS:

Every day practise counting forwards and backwards, starting at different numbers.

Year 1: Design an Easter Egg with a repeating pattern including different shapes and colours.

Year 2: Do the same as above. When you have filled your egg, imagine you have to carry on another 10 shapes. Can you work out what that shape would be?

This week in History/Geography:

You have learnt about Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus. Can you find out about another explorer and write about his/her adventures in your book?

This week in ENGLISH:

Write an acrostic poem about Easter using words such as Easter, egg, rabbit, celebration, chick, chocolate.

Write clues for an Easter Egg Hunt and place them around your house.



This week in SCIENCE:

Which planet in our Solar System would your spaceship land on? Find out all you can about this planet, draw a picture and write about it in your book.



Art/Design Technology:

Using materials around the house, make a spaceship and take a photo or draw it in your book.

Pick your favourite story from this week and talk to an adult about the character you think is best and why.

How many words can you create from the words EASTER CELEBRATION?

What is the longest word you can make?

Physical activity:

Have an egg and spoon race!
Try to move in different ways.
