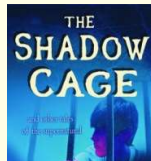

## English

Carefully read the story of The Shadow Cage. Imagine that you are one of the main characters (choose one) and write a series of diary entries, describing the events in the story from your point of view.



Read independently and discuss what you have read.

Listen to a story being read.

Use the 5/6 spelling list (available in your home school diary) to practise how to spell them. You could use them in a sentence.

Watch Newsround and discuss the topic with a member of your family.



Keep your own diary, describing your time at home, events in the world and your feelings about these things.

## Maths

Practise your time tables on Rockstars, Hit the button or Topmarks

Write out your 6, 7 and 8 time tables.

Design and make a board game linked to your times tables.

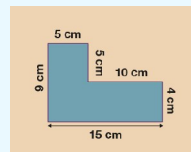


Make a fortune teller for the 6, 7 and 8 times tables. Remember the paper must be a square.

Test someone else on their time tables (you could use your home school diary)

Follow the Supermovers videos and chant your times tables.

Draw some compound shapes and calculate their perimeter.



## Science and Foundation subjects

Investigate the different materials that objects around the house are made from. Describe what the properties of that material are, that make it suitable for that job (ie glass is transparent, making it suitable for...)

Create a piece of art entitled 'Family'. This could be a self portrait, a sculpture or collage.



Play a board game.

FaceTime a family member you have not seen for a while.

Enjoy an indoors family picnic.



Research the story of The Princes in the Tower of London. Describe the events someone in your family and your view of what you think happened.

Make your own twig raft and try it out in a suitable place.
