- Stretch



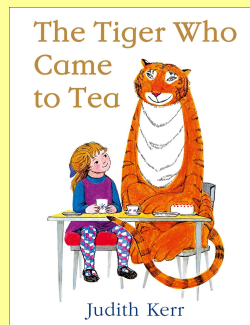
In Nursery, we will be practising peddling on the bikes and balancing on the scooters! Have you got a ride-on toy?

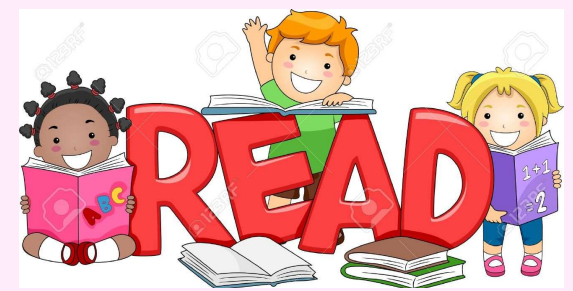
This week our theme in Nursery is one of Mrs Jones' favourites, 'The Tiger Who Came To Tea' by Judith Kerr.
