

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, was an Austrian composer, born in 1756. He is widely recognised as one of the greatest composers in the history of Western music.

Unlike any other composer in musical history, he wrote in all the musical genres of his day and excelled in every one. His first symphony was written when he was just 8 years old and was composed while he was in London on tour.

He produced 626 works in total.



Her life inspired the feature film 'Ammonite'. Crowd funding is taking place for a statue of Mary Anning and her dog to be erected in Lyme Regis.
