English

Practise your year 3/4 spellings by selecting 10 and writing each letter in a different colour. Challenge yourself by writing each word forwards then writing each word backwards.

Imagine you are interviewing the owner of a mythical creature, such as a phoenix, write a selection of questions you could ask them about keeping, catching or looking after the creature. Then write interesting responses using how, when and where phrases.

Using powerful and interesting adjectives, create a setting and start a story about someone stealing a magical creature from a king or queen. You can explore why your character needs to steal it and who they will give it to, perhaps to rescue someone.

Create a poem - Using a range of reading books, create a found word poem by choosing your favourite phrases and joining them together.

Create a snakes and ladders' themed board game using multiplication questions.



Design a fictional or non-fictional house. Use a ruler to measure the height and width of all the parts, such as the windows, doors, walls roof etc. First measure them using centimetres then try it millimetres.

Create a shopping list and practise our expanded columns addition method. You may find it helpful to convert pounds to pence when adding:

$$£2.25 + £1.55 = £3.79$$

Science and Foundation subjects

Research the weather around the world? Which countries are most likely to have a snowstorm, torrential rain, heatwaves etc... Find out about natural disasters such as forest fires, earthquakes, tsunamis, floods, tornados etc... How is climate change having an effect on the weather and natural disasters? Display what you find in a fun and creative way.

Using recycled materials design and make a recycling mascot to spread the word about the importance and need to recycle. Think about what it is going to look like? Which materials are you going to use? How are you going to join the materials together? Once completed, remember to evaluate your mascot. What would you do differently next time? Which parts did you find the most challenging and why?
