Good Morning Everyone

And, as ever, the 'powers that be' are not making it any easier in my final week – please see the summary of COVID arrangements from today.

COVID SYMPTOMS

YOU MUST NOT COME TO SCHOOL if you or a member of your household has any symptoms of Covid 19. The legal rules for 10 day self isolation and testing continue to apply.

COVID 19 ARRANGEMENTS FROM TODAY

From today there are changes to the legal requirements and guidance for schools to follow. I have summarised the main points below with details of the procedures we will have in place at this school (TPNS) for this final week.

Bubbles

'no longer recommend that it is necessary to keep children in consistent groups 'bubbles' TPNS - we will maintain our year group 'bubbles' as much as we are able.

Contact Tracing

'NHS Test and Trace will work with the positive case to identify close contacts. Contacts from a school setting will only be traced by NHS Test and Trace where the positive case specifically identifies the individual as being a close contact. Contacts in an educational setting will be traced if the positive case specifically identified an individual as having close, prolonged contact which will normally have occurred in a social setting e.g. sleepovers' TPNS - From 11.59pm last night schools' legal powers to require children to isolate ended. Although we cannot send a class or year group home to isolate, we will advise parents of any positive case (child/adult not identified). NHS Track and Trace will also be informed of any positive case, and they will work with the family to identify close contacts.

Face Coverings

From 19 July, face coverings will no longer be advised for pupils, staff and visitors either in classrooms or in communal areas.'

TPNS - we will encourage everyone to continue to wear face coverings in crowded communal areas.

Hygiene

'You should: 1. Ensure good hygiene for everyone. 2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.

3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated. 4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.'

TPNS - we will continue with our established measures until the end of term.

END OF YEAR ASSEMBLY

Our end of year assembly will take place on the Key Stage 1 playground on Thursday morning. We are just about able to fit the whole school community in this space but parents of award winners have been invited and seating will be provided for them.
