MATHS:

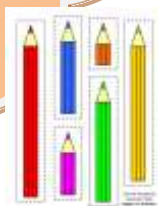
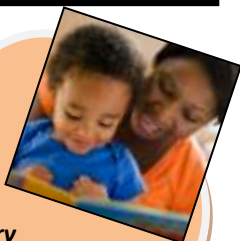
We will be practising counting objects, sounds and actions once.

We will be joining in with counting sequences, making numbers to 5 in different ways and looking at more than and fewer than with these numbers.

We will be comparing and matching numbers, and looking at the language of whole and part.

HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD?

- *Read to your child regularly and talk about what has happened in the story and what they think may happen next.*
- *Support them to blend the letter sounds they know together.*
- *Play number games, concentrating on numbers to 5 and 10. Look for numbers within numbers. eg. 4 is made of 3 and 1*
- *Look out for words, numbers, shapes.*



HOMEWORK: 10-15 minutes of daily reading, including tricky words and letter sounds labelled 'Phase 2' in the front of our reading diaries. Sharing and talking about the fiction/non-fiction books that your child will also be bringing home with them.
