English

- ✓ A flashback is usually shown in writing by introducing the fact that the character is day-dreaming about something in one paragraph, then ending with ellipses ie:



"The teacher remembered back to the time when he had his whole class working together..."

- ✓ The next paragraph describes what he remembered and starts with ellipses ie:
"...As he looked at his beloved class, all that could be heard was the sound of writing, only interrupted by small bursts of conversation and, occasionally laughter, as the class worked together on their stories.

- ✓ Use this format to describe a character remembering 3 different events.
- ✓ Don't forget to describe the character and what they are doing between memories, which reminds them of the event.



Exercise

Create your own dance to a piece of music you enjoy. It can be any style of dance you want- just express yourself! It's up to you whether you perform to an audience! Find a space outside 10-20 paces long if possible. How many times can you run between the 2 points without stopping. Try to beat this every day. Try to beat the time too!

Maths

- Get a family member to test you on your 7, 8 and 9 X table but not in order! Make a note of those you can't recall instantly, learn them and try again.
- Using your knowledge from last week's work, calculate the perimeter, then the area of 3 rooms in your house. You may need to borrow a tape-measure. If you haven't got one, use paces, with one long pace = 1 metre.
 - To extend yourself further, find a room that is irregular (not just one rectangle). To find the area, you will need to divide it into different rectangles, calculate the area for each, then add them.
 - If you have time, design and draw a plan of your perfect home. Calculate the perimeter and area of the rooms, pools, gyms etc!



Science and Foundation subjects

- Study an insect or animal in your garden. Create a 1 page informative poster about it to present to the class on our return. It should have an annotated diagram of the animal, along with information about habitat, diet, predators and any other information you want to add.

Art:

- There were some lovely bluebell pictures created last week. Use whatever medium you prefer (pencil, felt-tips, paint) to create an attractive scene that you can see from home. This could be flowers in the garden or a landscape you can see from a window.

French:

- Use the French that you know to write down a brief conversation between 2 people. This could be a greeting, followed by some questions about age, where you live, time etc or something more advanced!

PSHE:

Discuss your feelings about what you are enjoying about being at home and what you are looking forward to about returning to school. Stay positive!
