Reinforce capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, pen and cursive handwriting.

This week in **STEM**:

Talk about what happens to the chocolate. It **melts**, then **solidifies**.

Art/Design Technology:

Learn the song 'What shall we do from Jack and the Beanstalk. Follow Sarah Jane tutorial off website.

Cut a spiral drawn on green paper. Glue cotton wool at top to turn into your beanstalk growing into the clouds.

Phonics/Spelling:

Daily flashcard game (Beat the2 minute timer) Use all your phase 2/3 graphemes and tricky words.
