SCHOOL PLACES FOR KEY WORKERS

We have allocated places for eligible children across the school and have approximately 120 children attending (36%).

These were written prior to the national lockdown announcement but we will be aligning our daily/weekly work to these in order to cover the curriculum for the different year groups.

REMOTE LEARNING STRATEGY

Our Remote Learning Strategy has been revised for the current situation and is available on our website. As a school, we feel strongly that young children should

not be in front of a screen all day and this is certainly not what we do at school. The total set learning should take about 3 hours for key stage 1 and 4 hours for key stage 2.

We will continue to have 'live' contact using Zoom everyday with a teacher from the year group:

YR and Y1 9am

Y2 and Y3 9.30am

Y4 and Y5 10am

Y6 10.30am

This contact will be followed by set learning activities, the uploading of work and individual feedback on Tapestry. Teachers managing the online learning will respond to most work and questions between 9am and 3pm. Before and after these times, they will be reviewing and preparing for the next day. We are aware that this system has glitches beyond our control and we hope that these will be quickly be resolved by the company. If not, we will have to change providers but will keep you informed.

TECHNOLOGY

If you have any issues with lack of devices, data limitations, technical 'knowhow', internet access, Tapestry – then please get in touch.

ATTENDANCE

We will be monitoring children's engagement with their school work. As of Friday afternoon, 292/336 (87%) of YR – Y6 children had completed their work either at home or on site. This means there are 44 children across the school who have not engaged as yet and we will be in contact with parents later today to discuss your individual situation.

SAFEGUARDING

It is vital that we all keep ourselves safe online. We have written some online learning expectations for children, staff and parents/carers to follow (attached)

EXCHANGING BOOKS

We are very aware that children need access to a range of books and we are discussing how we can share our school resources with multiple homes whilst not increasing the risk to anyone. More information will follow.
