English

Read something unusual in an unusual place e.g. a cookbook in the bath. Try lots of unusual places to read in this week?

Read a magazine or newspaper article about a famous person. Write a diary entry from the viewpoint of that person.

Imagine that you are famous. What would you be famous for? Write a diary entry or story in written in the first person recounting the day's events.

Find out when the NHS began. Who was the founder? Compare the NHS then and now. Represent the information on a timeline or in an information booklet.



Write a list adjectives and place names that begin with the same letter e.g. fascinating France, delightful Devon, and terrific Tavistock. Can you put these into a list poem?

Maths

Think about these questions: What calculations can you create using the numbers 127, 111, 200, 28 and 65? Will you use subtraction, addition or both? Can you find the inverse to the calculations you write?

Are these number sentences true or false?

$$597 + 7 = 614$$

$$804 - 70 = 744$$

$$768 + 140 = 908$$

$$907 - 669 = 238$$

Give reasons.

Try to find real life arrays, this could be eggs in a tray, candles in a row, etc. Once found, write the calculation for that array. Can you find the fact family?

(E.g. $3 \times 4 = 12$, $4 \times 3 = 12$, $12 \div 3 = 4$ & $12 \div 4 = 3$).



Think about the products that you use at home and how far these have travelled. Food, clothing, toys and electrical items often carry 'Made in...' labels. Calculate distances travelled and order from those made closest to home to those made furthest away.

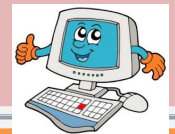
Science and Foundation subjects

Explore the reason behind why we need to brush our teeth. Research and draw a labeled diagram showing the different types of teeth you have, the names of each type and their uses.

Talk about how to stay safe when out exercising in your local area. Find out the facts and design your own poster explaining how to stay safe. You may want to include: Who you can exercise with, how far apart you should stay from others or if you need to wash your hands when you return.

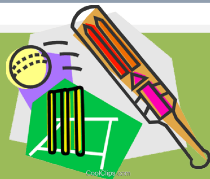

Find out and explore the different insects in an outdoor space. Do you find the same insects near trees that you can find under rocks? Create a tally chart to record your findings and go exploring!
