English

- Watch 'The Piano' again on You Tube:

- ✓ Investigate the techniques used in the film to show a flashback has taken place.
- ✓ Focus on these techniques for showing a flashback: gesture (how the character indicates with a look or movement); pan of the camera (how the camera moves upward or to the side); editing (special effects like characters being transparent, screen fading, images merging etc); costume (how clothing shows different periods of time)
- ✓ Use these 4 techniques to write down how each transition from present to past is shown in the film.
- ✓ Now think how you would describe each of these in writing. You will need to describe what the character is doing, what makes them remember the event and then describe the memory. Use ellipsis and a new paragraph to show the memory.
- Keep writing in your diary!
