

Summer Term 2 YR



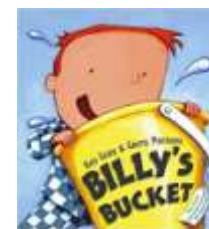
MATHS: We will be counting with numbers up to 20 and beyond.
