English



Write an acrostic poem about Easter or an Easter themed object.

Write a description of a fictional animal that has just been discovered. Think about what it looks like, where it lives and what it eats. Draw a picture to show what this new creature is like.

Write a set of instructions for how to look after a pet. Remember to include what you need and what you do.

Read independently and discuss what you have read.

Listen to a story being read.

Use the 3/4 spelling list (available in your home school diary) to practise how to spell them. You could use them in a sentence.



Exercise

Do a family workout (you could follow a video or you can make a workout up and get your family to follow you) or play an active game in the garden.

Maths

Practise your time tables on Rockstars (Remember, you can challenge your teacher.), Hit the button or Topmarks

Write out some addition question and use the strategies learned in school For example: $57 + 62 = 119$

$$\begin{array}{r} 62 \\ +57 \\ \hline 9 \text{ (2+7)} \\ 110 \text{ (60 + 50)} \\ \hline 119 \end{array}$$



Write word problems that involve adding in a real life context. For example: Mr Holt has 45 biscuits and then he buys 72 more. How many biscuits does he have altogether?

Add the ages of all the family members together. What is the combined age?

Follow the Supermovers videos and chant your times tables.

Science and Foundation subjects

Investigate the effect of friction on different materials. Choose 2 pieces of the same material and rub them back and forth for 30 seconds. See which materials feel the warmest. You could try: 2 sticks, 2 pieces of card, 2 pieces of plastic.

Create a junk model using recyclable items around your house.

Design an Ancient Egyptian themed board game to play at home.

For PE, create a mini circuit by setting up 6 stations (skipping, hopping, sit ups, squats, jumping jacks, running on the spot) 30 seconds exercise then 30 seconds rest then swap to the next station.

Help to make a meal with an adult.

Make a treasure map that could link to your Ancient Egyptian diaries.
