Therefore, 3 candidates undertook the recruitment process.</p> <p>The recruitment committee recommended that the Governing Board recruit Emma Byrom. Currently Headteacher at Princetown Primary School. Has been Headteacher for 6 years. Written her own Curriculum, which has been very successful. Previously at a large Primary School in Plymouth, KS1 Lead.
