

## Funky Fingers

Use the play dough recipe to make some sea themed play dough. Develop your fine motor skills by rolling, squashing, poking, squeezing, patting the play dough to the Funky Fingers music or by making a shark.

## This week in **MATHS**:



Use BBC Iplayer to watch an episode on Numberblocks daily. Concentrate on numbers 1-20.

Provide your child with a container. Ask them to make their container full, make it empty, nearly full, nearly empty, about half full. Can they find a container which holds more or less than their container? Provide your child with a set of similar containers in different sizes such as sets of nesting bowls or boxes. Your child will enjoy comparing and ordering them and seeing how many loose parts such as beads, cubes or corks they will hold. They could also use a small cup to fill each container, counting how many small cup-fuls the containers hold. Encourage your child to record their results using their own method of recording.



## This week in **STEM**:

### Boat Building

## This week in **ENGLISH/COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE**

This week we are going to write information about sharks. Where do they live? What do they eat? Which fact do you find the most interesting?

Underneath your shark picture write at least three interesting facts about sharks. Remember to extend your sentences by including adjectives and conjunctions and remember to use your beautiful cursive handwriting.

## Phonics/Spelling:

Practise daily name writing. (Boards can be cleaned with a cream cleaner!)

Daily flashcard game (Beat the 2 minute timer)

Use all your phase 2/3 graphemes and tricky words. Can you write a sentence that includes a cvcc, ccvc and a phase 4 tricky word?



**Physical activity:** Practise maintaining your balance whilst you hold a mini-front support position and reach round and point to the ceiling with either hand. Now place a cone/object on your back and take it off with the other hand.

## Understanding the World

Use the internet/ non-fiction books to investigate sharks. Discuss what facts you have discovered and make a list together. Can you think of 3 ways that a shark is different from a person? These facts will help you with your English this week.
