English

Read a story about a monster or creature. Then write about the creature. Write about what it looks like, what it eats, how it hunts, where it lives, its strengths and weaknesses etc. You could also draw it.

Practise your year 3/4 spellings by using as many as you can in a paragraph. I wonder if you can use them ALL!

Invent your own mythical/magical creature and write a description of how to capture it. Think carefully about the things that you must do and things that you must not do.

Write a description of an imaginary world. Think carefully about what is there, what can you see, hear, feel, smell and sense. You could link this to your creature and the land that inhabits.

Maths



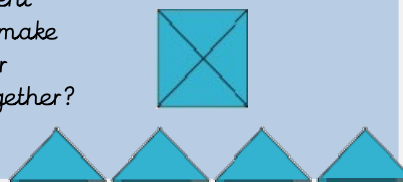
Complete a shape hunt around your house or outside space. How many 2D and 3D shapes can you find. Record it in a table.

Draw a picture using 2 squares, 3 triangles, 1 pentagon and 1 hexagon.

Make a cube from any material. Think carefully about how many faces, edges and vertices a cube has.

Practise your 3, 4 and 8 times tables. You can play different games to help you practice. You could even have a game of multiplication bingo with your family.

Draw a square (all the sides the same length). Cut the square into four triangles. How many different shapes can you make by fitting the four triangles back together?



Science and Foundation subjects

Have a go at the egg drop challenge. Investigate if you can drop an egg without breaking it. Think about what you could make or use to help your egg land safely, consider how you're going to make it a fair test. Record your results and create a labelled diagram of your design. The internet is full of amazing ideas if you want some inspiration.

Complete a bug hunt around your garden then create a table such as a tally chart and record your results. Explore if the weather affects your results by doing the hunt on different days. Create a bug hotel for the bugs you wish to have more of in your garden.

Plant a seed and watch it grow. You can find seeds outside such as dandelion seeds or you can use seeds from food in your kitchen such as tomato seeds, lemon, orange, avocado, peppers or apple seeds. Record your findings by drawing the stages of development with the date.
