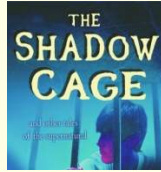

English

Suspense is created really well in *The Shadow Cage*. Find the place in the story where you first think suspense is created. How does Phillipa Pearce create suspense? Draw up a list of success criteria for creating suspense in writing. Use these success criteria to write a paragraph opening of your own with Suspense.



Read independently and Discuss how the main characters have developed. Listen to a story being read.

Use the 5/6 spelling list (available in your home school diary) choose 5 words you are unfamiliar with and research their meaning then use in a sentence.



Keep your own diary, describing your time at home, events in the world and your feelings about these things.

Exercise

Do a family workout (you could follow Joe Wicks on YouTube) timetable a run or bicycle ride or skipping activities. See if you can create your own simple exercise circuit to do at home. Maybe 4 or 5 different stations? Share it online.

Maths

Continue to practise your times tables on Rockstars, Hit the button or Topmarks. Use your same username and password to explore NumBots <https://play.numbots.com/#/account/search-school> Test your 7, 8 and 9 time tables. Try using the inverse (dividing) too.

Follow the Supermovers videos and chant your times tables.

Using the dice in your pack, roll the dice up to 5 times to create 8 numbers to 2/3 decimal places. Do 4 additions and 4 subtractions using them.

For example:

$$\begin{array}{r} 347.81 \\ + 46.922 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Think about your place value and the decimal point!

Now create 4-6 word problems involving addition or subtraction with decimals and answer them.



Science and Foundation subjects

Research what absorbent means. Find 5 different materials that you think are absorbent then design and carry out a test to find out which is the most absorbent. Take care to make it a fair test. What are the variables that need to stay the same?

Create a piece of art based on our investigation of landscapes with a medium of your choice



Play a board game.

FaceTime a family member you have not seen for a while.

Research who Guy Fawkes was and how he is linked to the Tower of London. Show what you have learned, using your own idea about how to present it (powerpoint, writing, diagram, diary entry)
